agencies and other English-speaking church leaders in Kyiv. Preparations are now underway for the January training.

## Sacrifice Leads to Transformation

Sergei rode the train for over 30 hours one-way; Christina left her 8 month old baby at home; Arpie gave of his family's meager wages—each of them sacrificing so they could attend the worship symposium.

Every time we host a conference or training we hear stories of sacrifice. In this case, people gave of their time, money and resources in order to learn



more about a topic that has hardly been addressed in Ukraine: worship. Greg Scheer writes in his blog, "Dave [Vroege] and I led sessions on the basics of worship--things we've heard and taught hundreds of times--but you could see lights going on around the room as people heard these ideas for the first time.

Worship as formation, worshipers as participants rather than audience, using the Psalms in worship--all of these were being heard with

fresh ears."

Although we've encountered a cultural avoidance towards personal improvement (whether it be parenting, marriage, health, budgeting, etc.), there are those who are eager to learn and grow. It is from these few individuals who not only attend but give up something in order to do so, that transformation takes place. When someone sacrifices, they value what they learn. When they value learning, they apply it to their lives. And it is in this moment that transformation begins.

## Financial Update

Missions is one way in which the members of the "body of Christ" work together. Through your prayers, encouragement, and financial support we are able to serve as your hands and feet. We see God transforming lives and building his church here in Ukraine!

The CRC has covenanted to provide 40% of the average cost of keeping a missionary family on the field. We are asked to seek the support of churches and individuals to (at minimum) meet the remaining 60%. At the end of the first quarter, we have received 22% of the minimum fund raising goal of \$72,600. We are \$2,000 be-
