friends came to pick us up and we managed to fit 5 passengers, a huge dog kennel, 15 suitcases and 5 carry-ons in their van. They hosted us for our last day and transported us to the airport in the middle of the night. Even though it took 3+ hours to get from the airport entrance to the gate, we made the flight to Amsterdam. Despite a KLM agent's mistake in Kyiv, our dog was cared for during the 5 hour layover in Amsterdam and we met her at our final destination in Chicago. George's dad met us in



Chicago with Trinity CRC's van and drove us to Grand Rapids. Thanks to many generous donations, especially from Silver Spring CRC, we entered a fully furnished house and are now settling into our home for the coming year. God has provided for all our needs through the countless acts of kindness and generosity of God's people. We are incredibly grateful.
