Ministering in Europe

Estonia

My Resonate colleague, Gary Timmerman, organized an HHTN event in Estonia to bring together Russians, Ukrainians and Estonians. We had about 20 participants, mostly senior pastors and other church leaders. God worked powerfully in their hearts.

Very deep repentance and forgiveness occurred between all the groups present. God seems to be opening doors in Europe to bring healing to the nations and revival to his church. We asked the most senior pastors from Russian and Estonia if they thought that HHTN was needed. Their response was a resounding "YES! Desperately needed!" I was able to speak at a prayer meeting as well as preach in a Russian Pentecostal congregation in Tallinn, and then in one of the largest Russian Methodist congregations in Tallinn the following Sunday. Everywhere the response was overwhelming. In the Pentecostal church almost 40 people came forward after the sermon for me to pray over them and to bring their pain to Jesus, our pain bearer. The following Sunday was Father's Day, so I was able to preach about knowing God as a loving father. There was a young girl who wept throughout the sermon. Her father had just abandoned her family. Her mother asked if we could pray for her. It was a precious time in which God was able to collect her tears (and ours). Pray that these seeds will grow into a giant tree of reconciliation that all the world would see. Some of the participants came from Russia, so we apologize, but no pictures allowed.
